



MENTOR- A TRAINER OF MENTORS

DISCOVER:

1. Intentionally look for a mentor today if you do not have one yet.
2. Intentionally start inspirational conversations and relationships with your mentees each week.
3. Identify a teaching, idea, or resource that you can implement with your mentees.
4. Discover any peer mentors near you, meaning: pastors with pastors, ministry leaders with ministry leaders, missionaries with missionaries.

TRAIN:

1. On the importance of preparing mentors in each ministry area.
2. Your mentees in the use of resources such as the wheel of life.
3. Sharing with mentees, in a simple way, what they have learned, as a model.
4. That all mentors must model and train mentors in the region.

EMPOWER:

1. Inspire and challenge your young leaders to pass on what you learned to their mentees.
2. Help them to reach their potential as mentor educators.
3. Accompany your mentees, so you will avoid loneliness and will see results.
4. To look at the beauty of their leaders and to look at the potential they have in Christ.
